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RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Union Depot is an historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, the Rotunda room may be rented by the public on limited occasions without interfering with the primary use of the Union Depot for mass transit purposes; and


WHEREAS, the patio area adjacent to the Rotunda Room may be rented if such rental event is to occur prior to April 23, 2001;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That community-based, non-profit, charitable organizations may rent the Rotunda Room for general civic or artistic purposes and that private citizens and/or businesses may rent the Rotunda Room for any function that is non-commercial, not for profit, not a solicitation for customers, not a solicitation of campaign contributions and does not engage in any activity promoting a commercial enterprise.
2. Rentals will be incidental to the mass transit purpose of the Union Depot.
3. That the patio area adjacent to the Rotunda Room may only be rented if such rental event occurs prior to April 23, 2001.
4. Prior to any such use, renters shall enter into a written agreement with the City, prepared by the City Attorney's Office, including but not necessarily limited to such items as rental fee, cleaning, security services, permits, insurance and hold harmless clauses.




