Sun Metro to Run on Holiday Schedule on Independence Day

EL PASO, Texas – Sun Metro's fixed-route system will run on a **Holiday Schedule** on Thursday, July 4, 2019 in observance of the Fourth of July holiday.

Brio service as well as mitigation routes 90, 91, 92, and 93 will not be operating on the holiday as these routes do not normally run on Sundays or holidays. Only the following routes will run on city-designated holidays: 3, 4, 7, 12, 14, 15, 22, 33, 34, 35, 36, 41, 42, 43, 44, 50, 51, 52, 53, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 65, 66, 72, 73 and 83.

The El Paso Streetcar will operate from 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 a.m.

Sun Metro customer service line for fixed routes will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The administrative offices (10151 Montana), the Eastside Transit Center ticket office (1165 Sunmount), the Robert E. McKee Five Points Transit Center ticket office (2830 Montana Ave.), the Bert Williams Downtown Santa Fe Transit Center ticket office (601 Santa Fe), and the Northgate Transit Center (9347 Diana) will be closed.

All Sun Metro services and facilities will resume regular hours of operation on Friday, July 5, 2019.
