Park+Ride with Sun Metro to UTEP-Southern Miss Game

El Paso, Texas – Sun Metro’s Park+Ride service is the best way to get to and from the Sun Bowl stadium to watch UTEP Miner Football this season.

Parking at and near UTEP is at a premium, but football fans can roll past the parking logistics by parking at one of Sun Metro’s SIX Park+Ride lots and catch a direct route to the game. Come out and support the Miners as they play against the Southern Mississippi Golden Eagles at 6 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 24th. Park+Ride bus trips are \$3 roundtrip. Children 5 and under ride free and must be accompanied by an adult.

Exact change for fare box is encouraged. Drivers can provide change cards for bus-use only, but DO NOT have access to currency. Reduced fares and bus passes will NOT be accepted on these special routes.

Departure times will vary depending on location (see below). The public is asked to arrive early. The drop-off sites will be around Memorial Gym, located on the north end of the Sun Bowl Stadium. Fans will be picked up at the SAME location as the drop-off site for each of the routes. Return trips will begin at the end of the 3rd quarter.

Parking at all but two Sun Metro facilities is free, except at the Union Plaza Transit Terminal (\$7 per vehicle before 9 pm; \$10 per vehicle after 9pm and during special events) and the Glory Road Transfer Center. Parking is available on a first-come, first-serve basis. The public is reminded that the outside lanes along Oregon Street are bus-only lanes — parking is NOT allowed. Violators risk being towed.

- NO TAILGATING allowed in any parking garages
- NO COOLERS or UMBRELLAS allowed in the Sun Bowl (see full list of prohibited items at tailgating.utep.edu)
