

# STOP. LOOK. LISTEN.

• SAFETY TIPS FOR PEDESTRIANS, MOTORISTS & CYCLISTS •

- 1 LOOK both ways and LISTEN for the streetcar before you step into the crosswalk.
- 2 Only cross the tracks at a crosswalk when the WALK signal is on. Never walk in front of a moving streetcar.
- 3 Never walk, run, or play along the streetcar tracks.
- 4 When driving, pass the streetcar with caution. Never block the tracks while parking or changing lanes.
- 5 Never cut in front of a moving streetcar.
- 6 Park only at designated spaces along the streetcar route. Never block the tracks.
- 7 Pay attention to new signs, striping & signals all along the streetcar route.
- 8 Don't ride your bike along the rails: Your tires could get stuck. Always cross rails at a 90-degree angle.
- 9 Stanton (between Baltimore & Rio Grande) is now a 2-way bikeway. Bikes travel north and south on the same side of the street.
- 10 Never grab the back of a streetcar to be pulled along on your bike.
